Description	The higher education cooperation programme APPEAR is a programme of the Austrian Development Cooperation (ADC). Its aim is to implement a strategy for support of higher education and research for development on an academic institutional level in the ADC's priority countries and key regions. The overall objective is to strengthen the institutional capacities in higher education, research and management in the addressed countries through academic Partnerships with Austrian higher education institutions and master's and PhD scholarships as a contribution to effective and sustainable reduction of poverty. Two types of scholarships are available: *Master's and PhD scholarships that are bound to an APPEAR project *PhD scholarships that are awarded on an individual basis and thus not bound to an APPEAR Project Target countries: Austria, Burkina Faso, Ethiopia, Mozambique, Uganda, Bhutan, Palestine, Armenia, Georgia, Moldova, Albania, Kosovo
